1	<p>According to the RFP, the Procuring entity is "the Government of Jamaica, on behalf of the Jamaica Gas Trust", this seems to indicate the GOJ is the Procuring Entity and is doing the purchase.</p> <p>According to the RFP, the JGT is just an SPV. If this is the case, and the counterparty is directly JGT, why include as the procuring entity the GOJ? What is the GOJ Guaranteeing?</p>	<p>As noted in the RFP, A private sector Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV), the Jamaica Gas Trust (JGT), will be established and will be the legal counterparty to execute the various commercial agreements, including the SPA with the LNG Supplier(s), the TUA with the Infrastructure Provider and the GSAs with the Offtakers.</p> <p>The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) is facilitating the procurement of LNG Supply while the JGT is being established and capitalized as described in the RFP. The GOJ will not be providing any financial guarantees for this Project and will not be party to the execution of the SPA.</p>
2	<p>The Delivery period can be from 3 to 20 years, can you please clarify what's the Initial delivery date? The expected date of the first delivery?</p>	<p>As noted in the 3rd paragraph on page 58 of the RFP, the target in-service (first gas) date of the proposed LNG terminal is end of the 1st Quarter of 2014. The first delivery of LNG is to be scheduled to coincide with this target in-service date of the LNG floating storage & regasification terminal.</p>
3	<p>We intend to offer an alternative offer where we offer MMBTUS. Can you clarify what fuels can be used? (Fuel Oil, Diesel, etc.)</p>	<p>The type and quantity of acceptable alternative fuels for a BTU Proposal is noted in the table on page 60 of the RFP.</p>
